



COVID 19 OUTBREAK SITUATION REPORT FOR PALESTINIAN REFUGEES IN LEBANON

2993 Palestinian refugees have been confirmed positive since the start of the outbreak in Lebanon on 21 February, including 372 active cases 208 inside camps and 164 outside camps 2510 people have recovered and 111 died the majority of the cases have been able to recover in home isolation, but 350 have been admitted to the hospital out of which 51 people remain hospitalized to reporting date and 81 were isolated in sablin (UNRWA vocational center) isolation center at of which 4 are still in isolation center till reporting date

Based on thorough review of the indicators in Lebanon, the Country was categorized as level 4 community transmission with very high incidence. That being said our camps are very crowded so higher transmission rate and due to the economic status in Lebanon and the curfew didn't help most Palestinian refugees can't afford basic necessity to prevent the disease from spreading due to that they find providing food for their families is more important than provide a mask or sanitizer

Support us to support them and give them hygiene kits to prevent the pandemic from spreading in our camps because health service that is provided to minimally support Health system in Lebanon is falling apart and there will be a time were the priority to be for Lebanese citizens in governmental hospital and most Palestinian can't even afford going to do the PCR test with your help we will be able to decrease the transmission rate in our camps and as a result support camp residents
